### EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S UPDATE

**O**n August 16th, Commissioner Andy Vanderlaan, Executive Officer Michael Ott and Consultant Harry Ehrlich attended the Coalition of California LAFCOs' monthly meeting in Santa Ana. Commissioner Vanderlaan was appointed as chairman of CCL and Michael Ott was designated as staff to the Coalition. These terms will last for approximately one year.

On August 11th, the Court of Appeals reversed a trial court decision upholding the Commission's decision on the Home Depot (City of El Cajon) annexation. The Commission will receive a closed session litigation update at the September 13th LAFCO meeting.

On August 13th, Michael Ott completed presentation materials for a seminar he will be giving on the subject of consolidation and LAFCO authority at CALAFCO's Fall Conference in Palm Springs.

On August 19th, LAFCO Legislative Director Harry Ehrlich provided a legislative update to the San Diego

Chapter of the California Special Districts Association.
