### 3. PROTEST HEARING | Dissolution of Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District | (RO18-09 et al.)

On September 10, 2018, the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) adopted a resolution approving the dissolution of Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District (JCFPD) and designating County Service Area No. 135 (CSA 135) as the successor agency. The LAFCo Resolution will be summarized at the hearing. Pursuant to the authority delegated by LAFCo and in accordance with Government Code section 57050, the Executive Officer shall hear and receive any oral or written protests or objections to the reorganization. All written protests must be submitted before the conclusion of the hearing. Any person who has filed a written protest may withdraw that protest at any time before the conclusion of the hearing. The hearing and valuation of the protests will be conducted in conformance with the Policy for the Conduct of Protest Proceedings adopted by LAFCo on October 1, 2018. Within 30 days of the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Executive Officer shall determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn and make the findings required by law.
