

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE
LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
FOR THE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW AND SPHERE OF INFLUENCE
UPDATE AND AMENDMENTS IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE “SAN DIEGO COUNTY
SANITATION SERVICES REORGANIZATION” (COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO) –
DISSOLUTION OF THE ALPINE[a], JULIAN[b], LAKESIDE[c], AND PINE VALLEY[d]
SANITATION DISTRICTS WITH CONCURRENT ANNEXATION TO THE SPRING
VALLEY[e] SANITATION DISTRICT OF TERRITORY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF
THE DISSOLVED SANITATION DISTRICTS, PLUS ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY
WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST OTAY MESA, HARMONY GROVE, AND
WINTERGARDENS SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICTS, AND THE CAMPO SEWER
AND WATER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a meeting of the Commission is scheduled for 9:00 a.m., on September 13, 2010, in Room 302, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, to consider the above-referenced proposals.

The proposed reorganization and sphere of influence territory includes approximately 58.4 square miles and is located in the unincorporated area of San Diego County. The reorganization proposal was initiated by a resolution of the County of San Diego. The reason for the proposal is as follows:

1. The reorganization will set a uniform rate and a standard level of service across all district service areas;
2. The reorganization will increase financial stability and rate stabilization;
3. The reorganization will provide a single governance structure;
4. The reorganization will increase flexibility for planning, funding, and implementing capital improvements;
5. The reorganization will allow for timely infrastructure maintenance, repair and replacement capabilities;
6. The reorganization will maximize use of regional Metro Wastewater System capacity rights, potentially saving rate-payers significant future costs; and,
7. The reorganization is consistent with the determinations of the amended County Sanitation Districts Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update.

State Law requires that notification of the impending annexation be published in a newspaper serving the area.

At the hearing, the Commission will hear any person who wishes to speak and will consider the application and report of the Executive Officer. The files may be examined in the LAFCO office.
