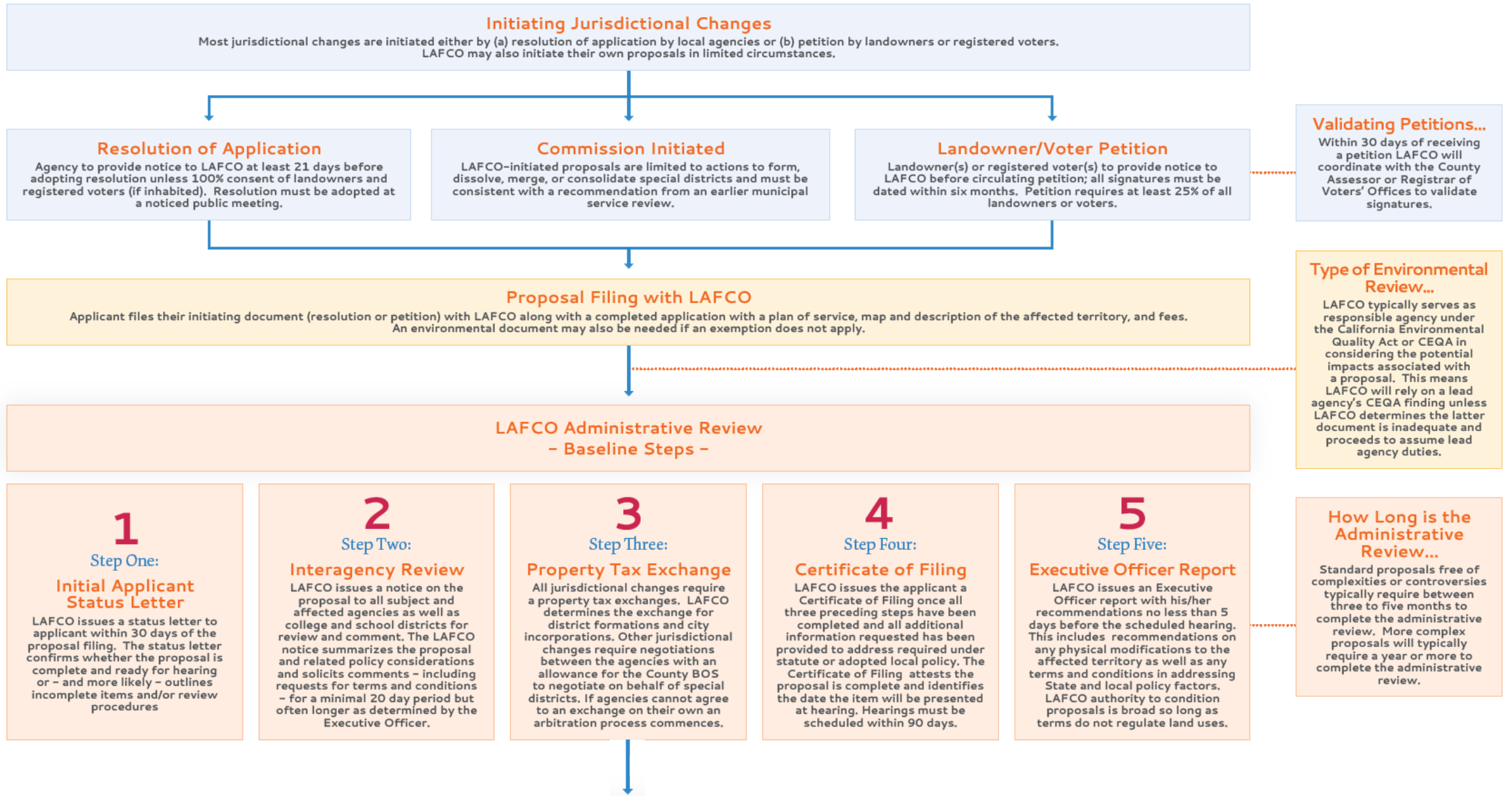




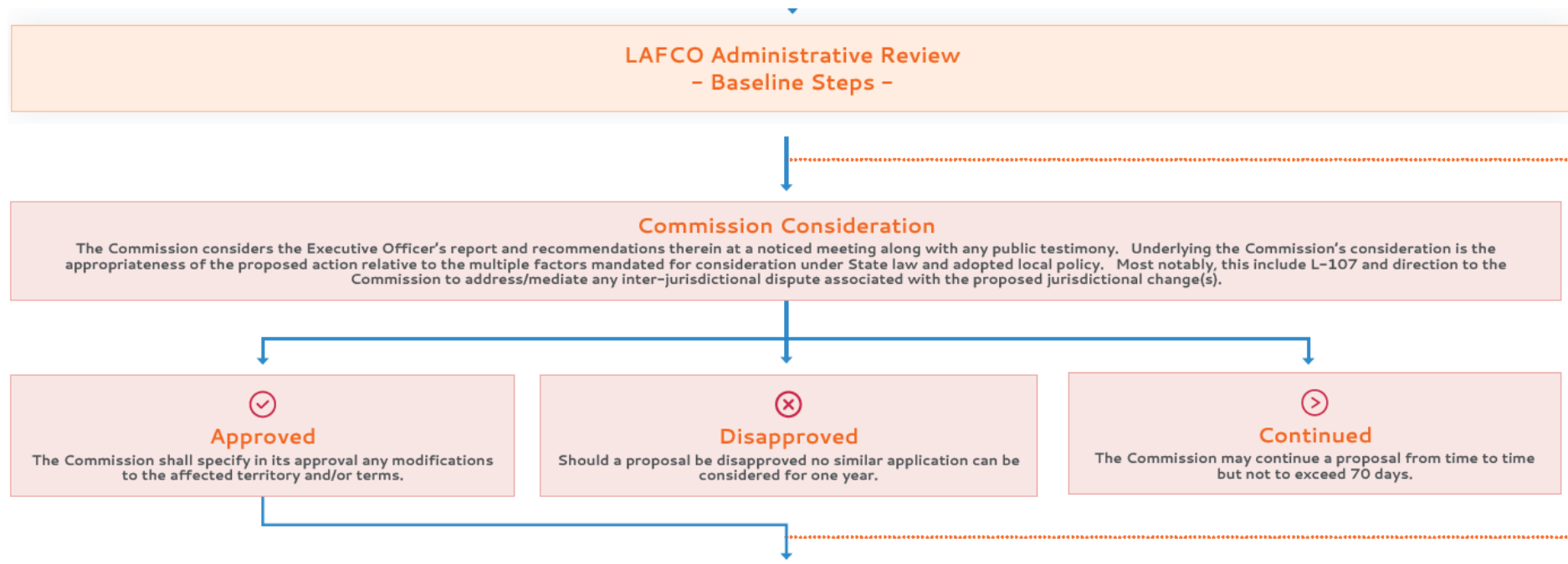

Phase Two: Commission Consideration



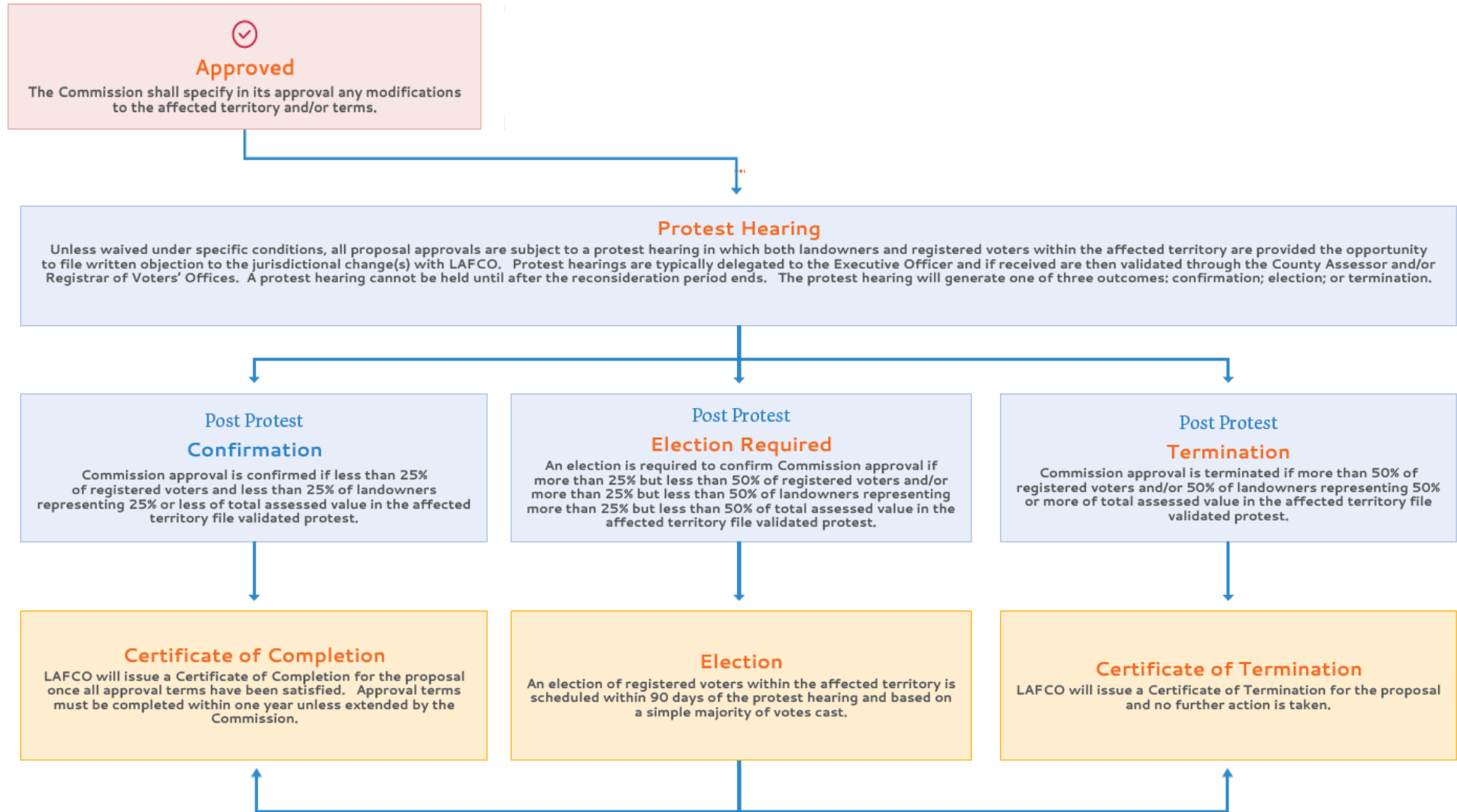
Who Gets Noticed About a Proposal...

If the proposal involves uninhabited (11 or less registered voters) territory and 100% of landowners have provided consent there is no expanded notice requirement. Otherwise, all proposals are subject to expanded mailed notice to all landowners and registered voters within the affected territory as well as within 300 feet no less than 21 days ahead of the hearing along with publication in the newspaper. Notice may be limited to the newspaper if the total number of mailed notices would exceed 1,000.

Reconsideration Period...

All actions by the Commission are subject to reconsideration where any member of the public - including individual Commissioners - may submit new information that was not considered at the time of the Commission action to approve or deny the application. Requests must be filed within 30 days of the Commission action and subsequently placed on the next available regular meeting agenda.

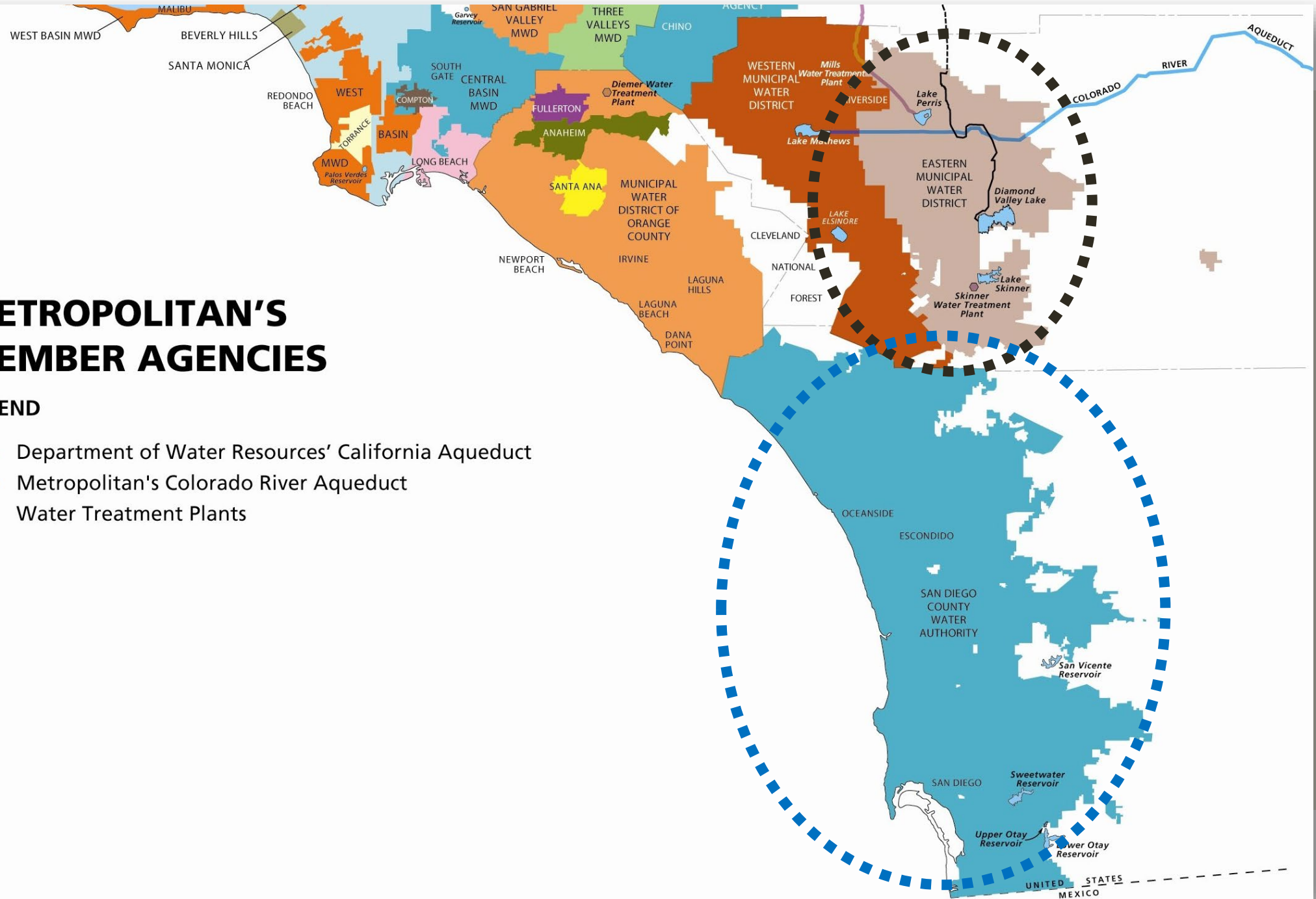




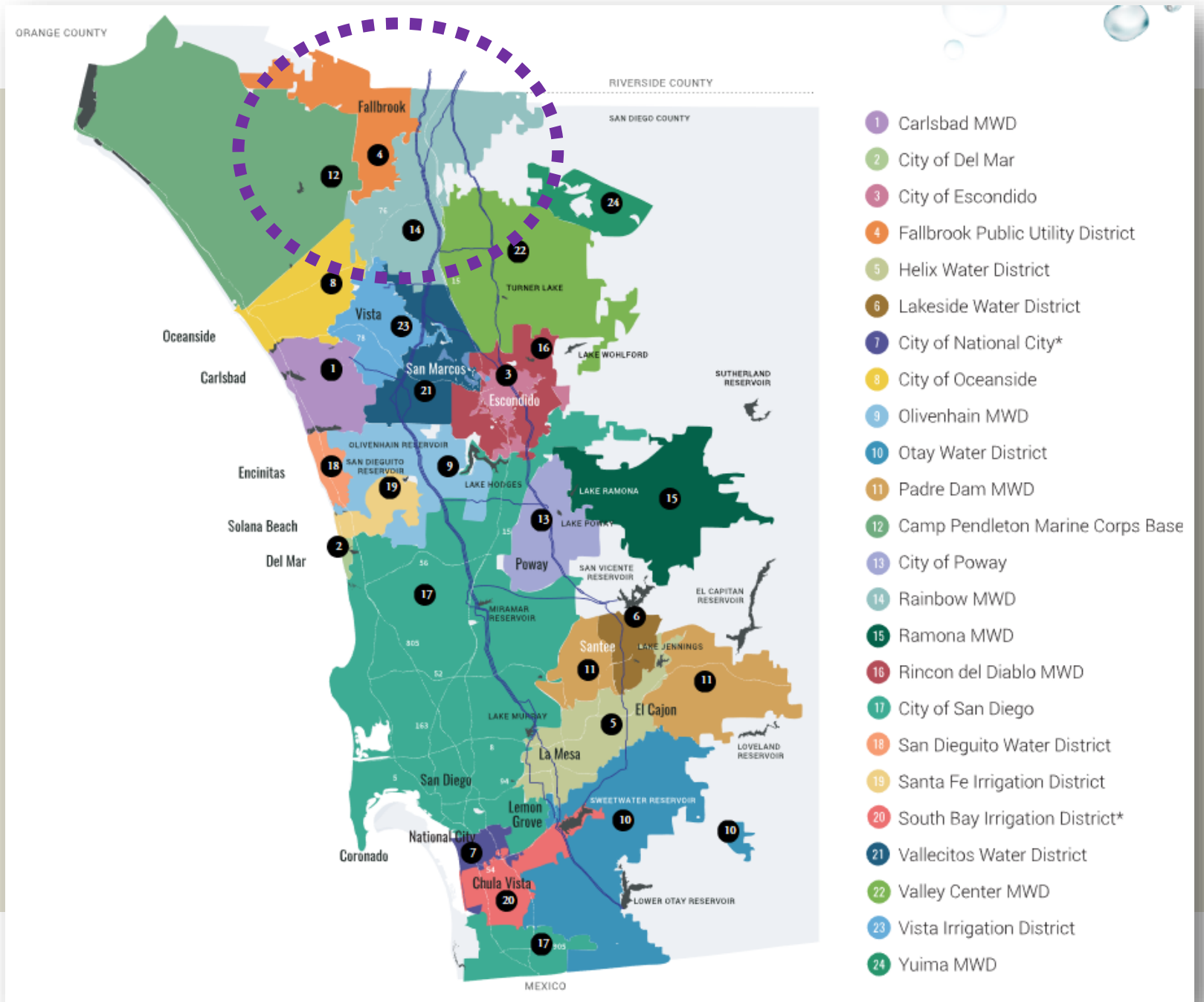
METROPOLITAN'S MEMBER AGENCIES

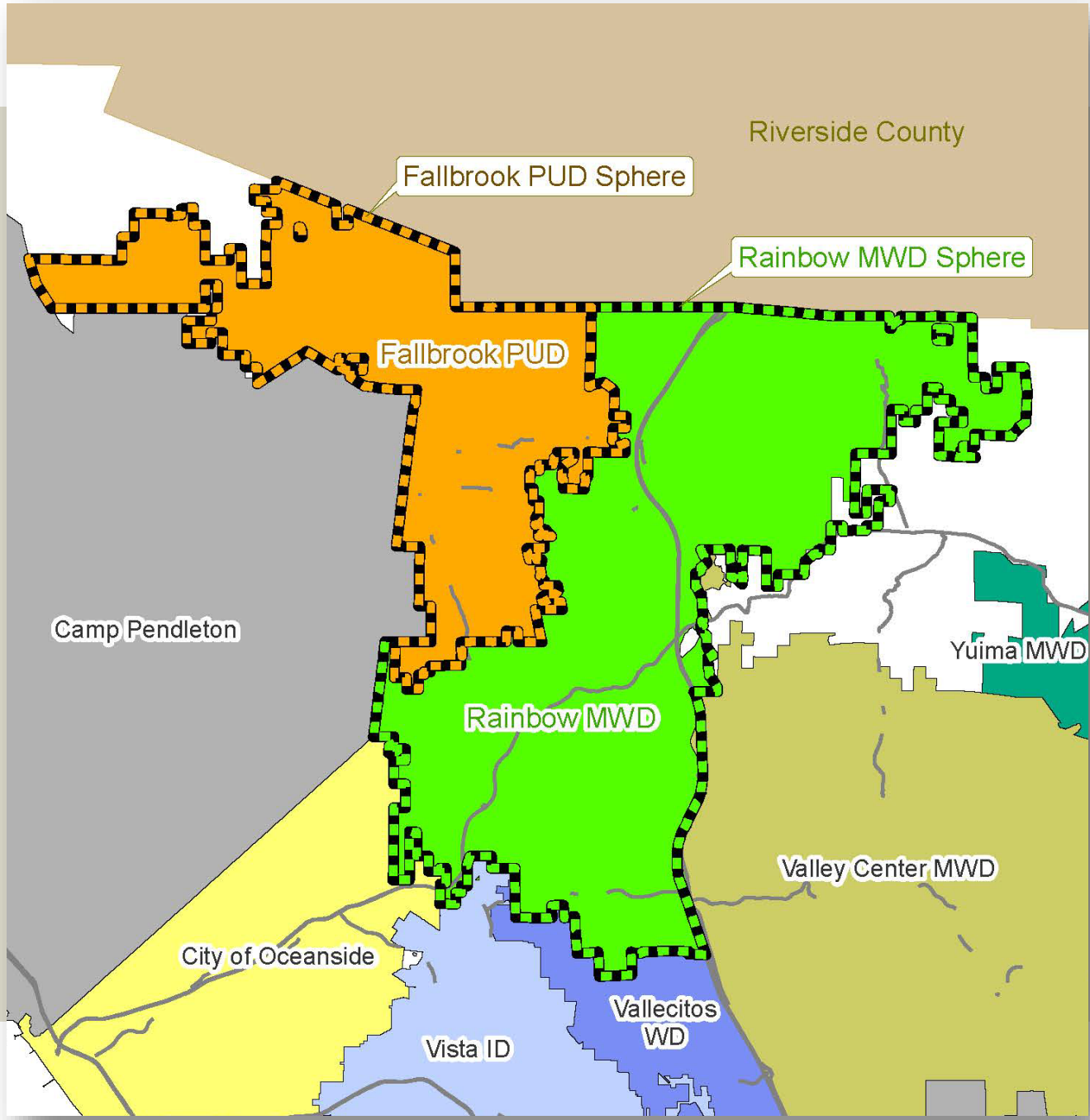
-  Department of Water Resources' California Aqueduct
