## Subject: Comments - Fallbrook PUD / Rainbow MWD Detachment Proposal

Dear Mr. Simonds:

Sweetwater Authority would like to provide comments for your consideration on the Proposed Fallbrook/Rainbow Detachment from the San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA).

As a member agency of the SDCWA, Sweetwater Authority (Sweetwater) is concerned about the impact the proposed Detachment will have on its ratepayers. Based upon information provided by the SDCWA, the detachment could cost Sweetwater rate-payers approximately \$250,000 annually (2020 dollars). When we consider the impact of the Detachment, along with the anticipated impacts of the water demand roll-off from the SDCWA associated with impending local project development (Pure Water San Diego and East County), we have a concern about the long-term viability of the SDCWA and its retail member agencies including Sweetwater.

Focusing on the current issue before LAFCO, we acknowledge that the proposed Fallbrook/Rainbow Detachment is unusual, complicated and contentious. As you progress through this very complex issue, we echo sentiments expressed by other retail water agencies that LAFCO focus on Fallbrook's and Rainbow's appropriate and legally-based one-time exit fee and/or ongoing financial contributions to the SDCWA and its member agencies. We would also encourage all four parties; Fallbrook PUD, Rainbow MWD, SDCWA and LAFCO, to work cooperatively to resolve the various issues driving the move for the Detachment, or at least minimize the conflict and public expense in determining the appropriate terms and other conditions for the Detachment.

We understand and support the process being undertaken by LAFCO and appreciate your careful consideration of all viewpoints and impacts. If detachment is ultimately approved, we believe that the fiscal transition should be phased in over a period of years. In this way, the financial impacts of detachment can be attenuated for all parties as is now done to offset the fiscal impact of member agency roll-off, albeit for a limited



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period of time, through provisions in the SDCWA rate structure.
