**3. PROTEST HEARING**

**a. San Diego County Fire Protection District Reorganization | (RO20-14 et al.)**

On October 5, 2020, the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) adopted a resolution to conditionally approve the reorganization of the County of San Diego to transition fire protection and emergency medical services provided by the County Fire Authority into a new dependent special district. The proposal involves the concurrent divestiture of fire protection and emergency medical service powers for County Service Area (CSA) No. 135 and formation of the San Diego County Fire Protection District (FPD) as the designated successor agency. The proposal's primary purpose is to provide a more effective governance model for the County Fire Authority to organize, fund, and deliver fire protection emergency medical services while retaining CSA No. 135's other function involving regional communications.

## PROTEST HEARING CONTINUED...

The affected territory is entirely unincorporated and comprises all of CSA No. 135's existing fire protection and emergency medical service area, covering approximately 1.6 million acres and an estimated resident population of 50,476.

The protest hearing has been scheduled by the Executive Officer consistent with adopted policy to receive written protests from affected landowners and/or registered voters within the affected territory to the change of organization. The LAFCO Resolution will be summarized at the hearing. All written protests must be submitted before the conclusion of the hearing. Any person who has filed a written protest may withdraw that protest at any time before the conclusion of the hearing. The hearing and valuation of the protests will be conducted in conformance with adopted policy. Within 30 days of the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Executive Officer shall determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn and make the findings required by law.
