Dear LAFCO members;

I am Roy Moosa, an elected representative of the Fallbrook Planning Group, speaking as a private Fallbrook citizen.

When I took office, like you, I was sworn in with the words:

“I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California...”

The first three words of the Constitution of the United States are “We the People.” These opening words intended to create a form of self-government where the people were embodied with the right to determine their own future.

The people of Fallbrook are exercising that right by determining a course for themselves that will save costs and improve their quality of life.

They are asking you, the sworn members of LAFCO, to uphold their right to determine their own future and well-being by voting to approve Fallbrook Public Utility District and Rainbow Municipal Water District to detach from the San Diego Water Authority.
