

The proposed dissolution and latent powers expansion proposals involving the Pine Valley and San Diego Rural Fire Protection Districts (FPDs) were approved by the Commission on August 3, 2015. Both proposals contained a number of terms and conditions that need to be fulfilled prior to the respective effective dates for the associated jurisdictional changes. All LAFCO proposals, including the above referenced proposals, are deemed terminated if terms and conditions are not satisfied within one year after the LAFCO approval date, unless a time extension has been authorized by the Commission or Executive Officer. County Fire Authority Manager Herman Reddick has indicated that additional time is needed to satisfy various conditions of both proposals. Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission approve a one-year time extension to provide the applicants additional time to wind up the affairs of the two districts

proposed for dissolution. If the Commission grants this time extension, then the \$1,400 time extension fee (\$350 fee for each jurisdictional change) for both proposals should also be waived, because the proposals are in response to Commission recommendations to improve fire protection services in San Diego County. It is therefore.

**RECOMMENDED:** That your Commission authorize a one-year time extension to August 7, 2017 for the above referenced proposals and waive the associated time extension fees.
