

MINUTE ORDER

March 4, 2024 Regular Meeting Agenda Item No. 8a

At its March 4, 2024 meeting, the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) took up Agenda Item No. 8a as part of its regular business Item 8a involved the Commission receiving a final administrative assessment on LAFCO's oversight duties as they relate to the San Diego Unified Port District for possible action. The staff presentation was provided by the Executive Officer and proceeded by public testimony and discussion by the Commission. At the conclusion of the discussion, Commissioner Becker made a motion to APPROVE the staff recommendation - identified as "Alternative One" - with a second from Commissioner Drake (voting) to do all of the following:

- a) Accept the final administrative assessment as presented;
- b) Approve a conforming policy statement confirming the Port District is an independent district subject to LAFCO's oversight; and
- c) Authorize the Executive Officer to effectuate the above policy determination to add the Port to the annual appointment as well as add the Port District as an eligible voter on the Independent Special Districts Selection Committee.
