SUBJECT: Results of Protest Hearing

> Conditionally Approved "City of Carlsbad Change of Organization" Detachment from Leucadia Wastewater District and Concurrent Sphere of

Influence Action (LAFCO File No. CO23-09)

SUMMARY

The San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will receive the results of the protest hearing held for the "City of Carlsbad Change of Organization." This change of organization was conditionally approved by the Commission in February 2024 and involves the detachment of three non-contiguous areas within the City of Carlsbad from the Leucadia Wastewater District (WD). The noticed protest hearing was held on April 3rd. No protest was filed at the close of the hearing. The protest hearing results are being presented for the Commission to formally receive and file.

BACKGROUND

Proposal Summary

San Diego LAFCO received a change of organization proposal filed by the City of Carlsbad in July 2023 seeking Commission approval to detach approximately 202 acres of incorporated territory from the Leucadia WD. The affected territory comprises three non-contiguous inhabited areas developed largely with residential and commercial uses along with public

open space. The affected territory consists of 50 legal parcels that are further defined with 277 unique assessor parcels with the latter reflecting several properties that are under tenancy in common ownership agreements. The estimated resident population within the affected territory is 1,235. The proposal's purpose is to eliminate an existing boundary overlap between Carlsbad and Leucadia WD and in doing so make explicit the City is the sole authorized provider of public wastewater services going forward. A map of the affected territory is provided in Attachment One.

Commission Action

On February 5, 2024, San Diego LAFCO held a noticed public hearing to consider the change of organization proposal filed by the City of Carlsbad. The Commission proceeded to conditionally approve the change of organization with no modifications. The Commission also delegated protest hearings to the Executive Officer as allowed under statute and local policy.

DISCUSSION

This item is for San Diego LAFCO to receive the results of the protest hearing delegated to the Executive Officer involving the Commission's earlier approval of the subject change of organization proposal as required under the policy. Protest for the proposal opened on Monday, February 12, 2024, and concluded at a hearing held on April 3, 2024, at the Carlsbad Municipal Water District. Notice of the hearing was provided in the manner allowed under statute and included publishing a 1/8th page advertisement in the San Diego Union-Tribune as well as voluntary mailed notices to all landowners and registered voters within the affected territory. No written protest was received through the end of the hearing from affected landowners or registered voters. With the preceding results in mind, the Executive Officer has proceeded to execute a confirming resolution ordering the change of organization. The change of organization will become final once all terms have been satisfied.

ANALYSIS

San Diego LAFCO's approved detachment of approximately 202 incorporated acres within the City of Carlsbad from the Leucadia WD has cleared its last substantive threshold. All remaining actions necessary to record and enact the change of organization are ministerial.¹

San Diego LAFCO policy directs the Executive Officer to proceed and issue an ordering resolution at the conclusion of the protest hearing process so long as the results do not require the proposal to be terminated or confirmed by an election. The Executive Officer is also responsible for informing the Commission of the protest results resulting in an action being ordered at the next regular meeting. [Policy on Conducting Protest Hearings Section 4(h)].

NOTICE OF SCHEDULED PROTEST HEARING "CITY OF CARLSBAD CHANGE OF ORGANIZATION" LAFCO FILE NO. CO23-09

of The above-listed change of organization was initiated by resolution of the City of Carlsbad and involves the detachment of 3 non-contiguous areas from the Leucadia Wastewater District. The purpose of the proposal is to nt eliminate an existing overlap between Carlsbad and Leucadia be Wastewater District and in doing so better align the agencies' respective ss wastewater service areas consistent with their current and planned infrastructure. The proposal was conditionally approved by San Diego LAFCO at a noticed public hearing on February 5, 2024. A summary description of the areas making up the affected territory follows.

"Area 1" represents the portion of the affected territory within Carlsbad's southern coastline along Carlsbad Boulevard between Island Way and San Marcos Creek.

"Area 2" represents the portion of the affected territory within the Voscana neighborhood located off Poinsettia Lane and its intersection with Artemisia Court.

"Area 3" represents the portion of the affected territory within the La Costa neighborhood located off of Dove Lane near its intersection with El Camino Real.

Additional details of the proposal – including a map showing all three areas comprising the affected territory – is available online at www.sdlafco.org by accessing the "Meetings" page and staff reports for the February 5, 2024 meeting.

Commencing on Monday, February 12, 2024, San Diego LAFCO will accept written protests filed by landowners and/or registered voters within the affected territory up and until the close of the protest hearing set for Wednesday, April 3, 2024 at the above listed time and place. Written protest filed before the formal hearing may be submitted by p.m. on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. Otherwise, all protests must be submitted in person at the noticed hearing. Each written protest shall state whether th it is made by a qualifying landowner or registered voter. It shall also m identify the property location or assessor's parcel number(s) of (landowner) or residence address and be signed and dated. All signatures must be dated after the publication of the protest hearing notice.
